
2020-2021 DVUSD Budget Revision

- ► A.R.S. § 15-905(E)-1 requires schools districts to complete a December budget revision if the adopted district expenditure budget discrepancy exceeds the ADE calculated General Budget Limit by 1% or more.
- ▶ Due to a decrease in enrollment from projection for the 2020-2021 school year (FY21), DVUSD meets this requirement.
- ▶ Budget revisions completed for this purpose must be completed by December 15, 2020.
- ▶ All other budget revisions must be completed by May 15, 2021.



Revision Compared to Adopted




2021-2022 Budget What to Watch

- ▶ One Time 2020-2021 Budget Elements Not Available for 2021-2022
 - \$12.8 Million Enrollment Stability Grant
 - \$ 7.8 Million Carry Forward from Prior Year (Assuming \$6M in FY21)
 - ▶ \$.9 Million New School Fund

\$21.5 Million One-Time Funds Used in the FY21 Not Available in FY22*

*ESG and New School Fund are one-time only, carry forward varies from year to year.
