Label Goal

Excellence in Student Learning: DVUSD will raise student academic achievement and social emotional learning to prepare our graduates for college and careers.

By the end of the year 2021-2022 school year, 100% of CE students in grade K-4 will increase the WWR and decrease the number of students in the intensive category according to DIBELS based on K-CLS; K-WWR, 1st-ORF, 2nd-ORF, 3rd-ORF. 4th-ORF. K-4 DIBELS goal is to have less than 17% of students are intensive, at each grade level, by the end of the school year. Through more focused collaborative PLC meetings during the 21-22 school year, we are hopeful to continue to decrease the number of intensive students.

By the end of the year 2021-2022 school year, 100% of CE students in grade 5th-6th will be increase there growth on the district ELA assessment, and no more than 25% will be in the intensive category at each grade level.

By May 2022, 48% or more of our parents will agree or strongly agree that they 'are aware of teacher collaboration content on early release days." (FY 21- 43%)

By May 2022, we will increase the percentage of parents who respond to the Parent Satisfaction Survey from 1% to 6%.
