



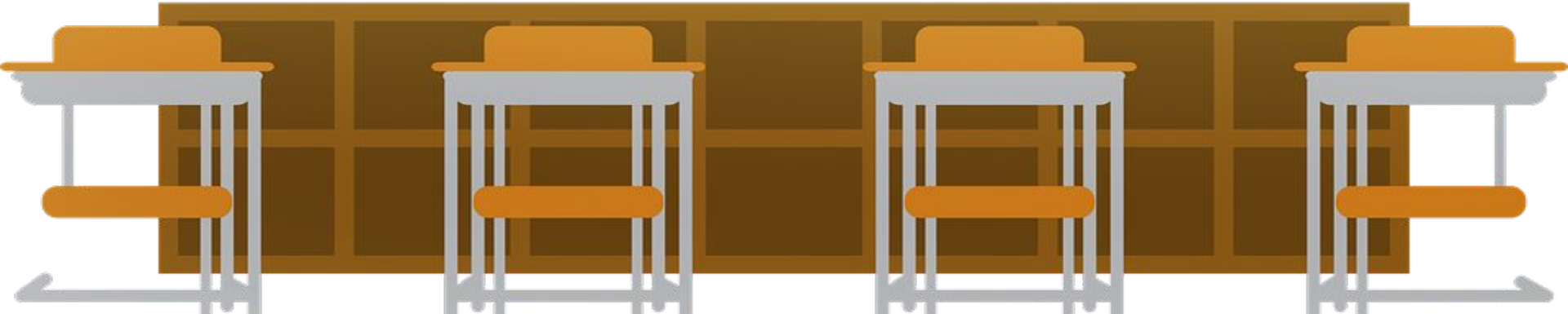

- Attend Learning Center Zoom lessons when scheduled





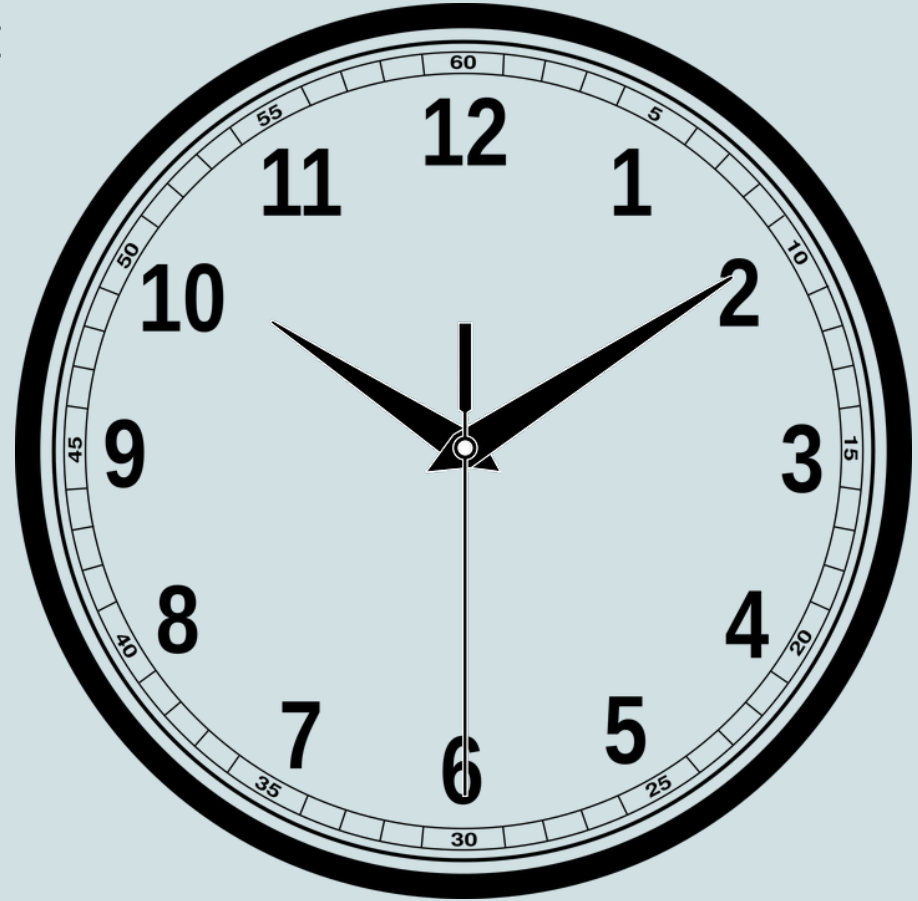
Supplies You will need!
