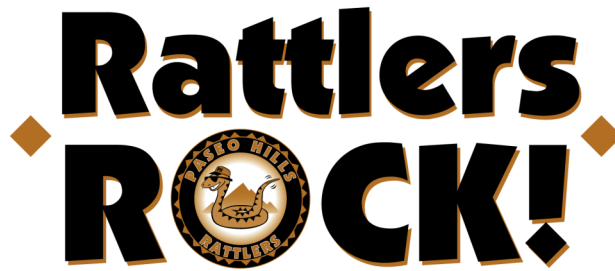

SOCIAL SKILLS GROUP (SSG)

What is it?

An inclusive, peer social interaction group allowing students to develop skills that may include positive communication, self-advocacy, problem solving, and/or conflict resolution to promote a positive campus climate.

Purposes for the student:

- To learn to identify and express feelings appropriately.
- To learn healthy communication skills.
- To become a model of respect towards self and others.
- To learn we are responsible for our own lives, and based on our choices, have the power to change.
- To become a classroom and campus leader that will positively promote school wide ROCK expectations.

Expectations for the student:

- Everyone is to be treated with respect.
- Everyone has the right to share at their own comfort level.
- Everyone has the right to be heard.
- Be on time.
- Everyone speaks for him/herself.

How was my child chosen to participate?

Students may be referred to SSG if staff have identified potential leadership skills to be developed or fostered. SSG is also an opportunity for some students to engage in positive, meaningful peer interactions and build supportive peer relationships. Students may also be identified to participate based on behavior trends that would be positively impacted by additional skills and leadership opportunities.

How can I help at home?

Research shows that students are most successful when the home and school work collaboratively together to support the child. You can support by:

- Encouraging regular attendance
- Asking about skills learned in group
- Sharing personal experiences related to the skills being taught
- Encouraging your child to generalize the skills into your home setting
