

DVUSD DUAL LANGUAGE IMMERSION COMMITMENT FORM 2021-2022

Thank you for choosing the DVUSD Dual Language Immersion Program for your child! Dual language immersion (DLI) is a rich and challenging experience, but one with a lifetime of reward! In order to ensure that every student has a high probability of success, we would like parents to fully understand the commitment to the program.

As a parent/guardian of a child in the DVUSD Dual Language Immersion Program, I understand and commit to the following:

- 1. I understand that students will receive instruction in the target language for 50% of the day; and in English for 50% of the day. Math and science will be taught in the target language; English language arts and social studies will be taught in English.
- 2. I understand that parental involvement is highly correlated with success at school. I will support my child academically by showing interest in school, supervising homework, volunteering to assist teachers, providing tutoring when necessary, and communicating with the teacher.
- I understand that parental involvement is also highly correlated with the development of my
 child's English proficiency. I will provide my child with experiences that will enhance their English
 language and literacy development, such as reading with my child in English daily for 20-30
 minutes.
- 4. I understand I do not have to speak the target language. However, I will do my best to support my child in the development of the language at home by encouraging them to read in the target language and complete enrichment activities.
- 5. I understand that it is not unusual for children to experience some frustration and fatigue, particularly during the first few months of the program. I will encourage my child to persevere, and will praise my child for demonstrating grit and making progress.
- 6. I understand that learning a second language takes time. I am committed to keeping my child in DLI for the duration of the program, knowing that language proficiency takes many years.
- 7. I understand that students in the DLI program are held to the same academic standards and will participate in the same district and state assessments as any other student in DVUSD.
- 8. I understand that if my child has any academic/behavioral concerns, I must work with the teacher to positively resolve any issues. Appropriate interventions and strategies will be implemented if necessary. If documented interventions are unsuccessful, a formal conference will take place, perhaps resulting in reassignment to a full-day English classroom.
- 9. I understand that I must provide transportation to the school if I do not reside within the school's boundaries.
