1. **AEF:** American Expeditionary Force. The name given to the American Army in the Great War.
2. **Allied Powers Triple Entente:** England, France, Russia, United States
3. **Central Powers/Triple Alliance:** Austria Hungary, Germany, Italy, the Ottoman Empire
4. **Committee on Public Information:** Created to influence U.S. public opinion regarding American participation in The Great War.
5. **Espionage Act:** Provided penalties for anyone who obstructed in the recruitment of soldiers or sold military secrets to the enemy.
6. **German Unrestricted Submarine Warfare:** Germany would attack any ship heading to England in an attempt to cut off British supplies.
7. **League of Nations:** A group of nations that gathered to discuss international conflicts and relations, Wilson's 14th Point (Predecessor to the United Nations)
8. **Sedition Act:** Provided penalties for anyone who spoke out against the U.S.'s involvement in the war.
9. **Selective Service Act:** All males between ages 18-45 are required to register for the draft
10. **The Lusitania:** A British luxury liner carrying weapons from the USA to Great Britain, sunk by a German U-Boat in May 1915. 124 Americans died.
11. **Treaty of Versailles:** The treaty that ended the Great War.
12. **Neutrality:** When a country does not support either side in a conflict/war
13. **War Industries Board:** Was set up to coordinate the purchase of war supplies, set production quotas and allocated raw materials.
14. **Wilson's Fourteen Points:** President Wilson's goals for the Treaty of Versailles.
15. **Zimmerman Note:** A proposal made by the Germans to Mexico asking for help fighting the Americans allowing Mexico gain back land they lost to the U.S in the Mexican American War.
