
New Modernized School: The Traditional Academy at Bellair

RECIPE: AVENUE 27 SALSA

Ingredients:

- · 6 Roma Tomatoes
- · 1 Dried Ancho Chile
- · 2-3 Chile de Arbol
- ½ Cup roughly chopped yellow onion
- ¼ Cup roughly chopped cilantro
- · 2 Cloves garlic
- · 1Lime
- · ½ tsp Cumin
- · 1 Cup water
- · Salt and Pepper to taste

Directions:

- 1. Cut tops off the Ancho and Arbol chiles and remove as much of the seeds as possible.
- 2. In a dry skillet on medium heat, toast the ancho and Arbol chiles for approx. 30 seconds a side or until fragrant and slightly darkened.
- 3. Once chiles are toasted, transfer them to a bowl filled with hot water and let soak for 15 minutes or until softened.
- 4. Drain water and transfer to blender.
- 5. Quarter tomatoes and add to the blender, along with onion, garlic, cumin and half of the water.
- 6. Blend salsa until smooth, and then add in cilantro and juice from lime and blend for a few seconds more to incorporate. Thin with the additional water if needed.
- 7. Season with salt, pepper, and transfer into a storage container. Refrigerate for 1 hour or up to overnight before serving.
