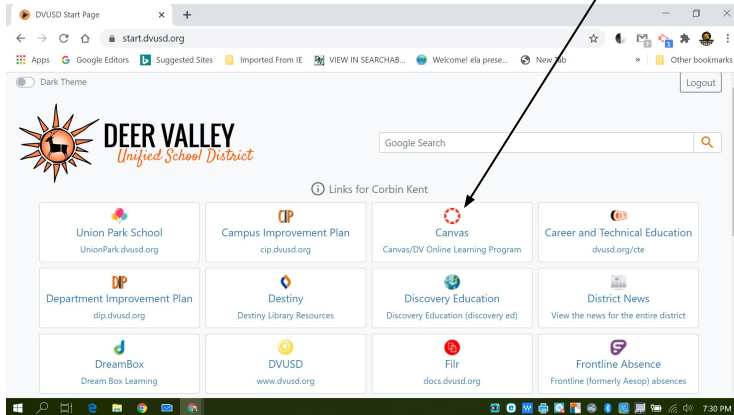

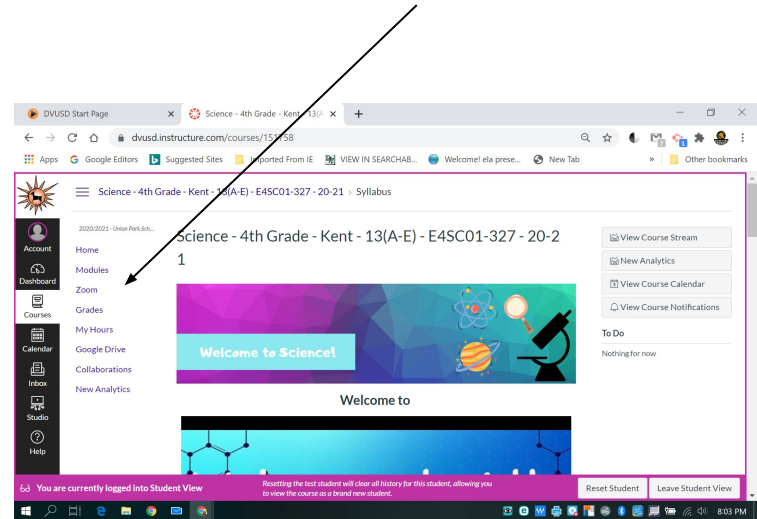
CANVAS
