

# ♥ Welcome to Kindergarten

**Please bring supplies to Meet the Teacher Event or on Friday, August 5th,**

**Please do not send supplies on the first day of school**

## **Individual - Please label with your child's name.**

- A pair of headphones (no earbuds) in gallon size Ziploc and label the bag with your child's name.
- A regular-sized backpack (*no wheels, tiny-sized or stuffed animal backpacks*). Please no toys, key chains, watches or trinkets on your child's backpack.
- Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name containing a change of clothes
- Water bottle labeled with your child's name (bring daily)
- Scissors (blunt tip)
- \$10 to cover the cost of Scholastic News & Science Spin (Social Studies/Science)

## **Community - Do not label with your child's name.**

- Package of Expo dry erase markers
- 1 Pkg Crayola markers
- Box of 24 count Crayola crayons
- 2 5 oz. containers of Play-Doh (any color) optional

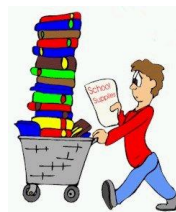

### For Personal Use, to be kept in personal backpack:
