



Parent/Guardian Access to Student Grades In PowerSchool

Parents and Guardians can access student current grades, past grades, and grades for learning standards in PowerSchool.

1) First, you must have a PowerSchool account. If you have already created a Parent PowerSchool account, go to step 2.

If you do not have a Parent PowerSchool account, you will need to create an account by completing the following steps:

- Go to ps.dvusd.org/public
- Click on “Create Account”
- Enter information to create an account
- For each child, enter the student’s name, Access ID*, Access Password*, and your relationship to the child.

**Access ID and Access Password can be obtained from your student’s school.*

1. Click Create an Account.
