Needs Statement

Students in grades K-6 struggle to meet the benchmark scores on benchmark assessments. When examining the root cause, we determined that students struggle for different reasons. Some require phonics skills, some fluency practice, some comprehension, and many have a combination of these needs. We also discovered that using small group instruction as a practice to reach the needs of the students is a need for the teachers. Teachers require additional training and understanding of what small group instruction is, and how to implement it - time and structures.

Goal Description

By May 2018, 80% of students at each grade level, K-6, will demonstrate competency in reading by scoring as follows:
 Kindergarten: Strategic or Core on DIBELS Nonsense Word Fluency-Correct Letter Sound (NWF-CLS)
 1st and 2nd grade: Strategic or Core on DIBELS Oral Reading Fluency (DORF)
 3rd grade: Strategic or Core on DIBELS Daze
 4th, 5th, and 6th grades: Proficient or Advanced on the RI (Reading Inventory) assessment.
