**Needs Statement**

To support DVUSD growth, DC is utilizing our target card to increase by the following: 6% increase in AZMerit math scores, 6% increase in AZMerit ELA scores, 5% decrease in DIBELS intensive category, and 2% increase in AIMS Science.

The three year trend in DVUSD and within DC shows a drop within our K-3 DIBELS data in students within the CORE category.

**Goal Description**

Grades K-2 ELA Goals: By May 2018, Diamond Canyon will reduce our percentage of intensive students in DIBELS from 20% to 15% or less school wide.

By May 2018, 100% of students in grades K-2 will demonstrate mastery of the AZCCRS reading foundations standards: phonics and phonemic awareness, as evidenced by scoring 85% or showing measurable growth of 40% on the Quarter 3 DVRA.

Grade 3-8 ELA Goal: By May 2018, 100% of students in grades 3-8 will demonstrate mastery of ELA AZCCRS reading anchor standard 1: read closely, make inferences, cite textual evidence, and draw conclusions. This will be evidenced by scoring 85% or showing measurable growth of 40% on the Quarter 3 DVRA.

### Needs Statement

To support DVUSD growth, DC is utilizing our target card to increase by the following:

6% increase in AZMerit math scores, 6% increase in AZMerit ELA scores, 5% decrease in DIBELS intensive category, and 2% increase in AIMS Science.

Our district has seen a trend of higher intensive and strategic percentages the past three years within our K-3 students and DC plans to help close the gap to hit our target of 15% of less at the intensive level on the DIBELS assessment (2017 data was 20% at DC).

Math: We have four out of six grade levels with changes for math teachers for the 2017-18 in the state assessment grade levels. Therefore we are working on ensuring consistency with past math goals and school strategies implemented with all.

### Goal Description

Math:

Diamond Canyon 2018 AZMerit math school score will increase to 80% proficiency, a 6% increase from 2016-17.

100% of DC Kinder-5th grade students will demonstrate mastery of the AZCCRS in the area of Number Sense, as evidenced by scoring 85% proficiency or measurable growth of 40% on the Quarter 3 DVMA.

100% of DC 6th-8th grade students will demonstrate mastery of the AZCCRS in the area of Algebraic Thinking, as evidenced by scoring 85% proficiency or measurable growth of 40% on the Quarter 3 DVMA.
