**Needs Statement**

Analysis of classroom walkthrough and district common assessment data revealed a need to align instruction and curriculum by content course area, in order to ensure our students graduate with access and mastery of agreed upon essential outcomes. Deer Valley High School has used this as a targeted goal for the last two years. With curriculum changes this is an ongoing process and is at the core of our work.

Analysis of state assessments were used to created target goals for continuous improvement. Deer Valley High School received a B (78) letter grade form ADE. An increase in both growth and proficiency rates will increase our score and letter grade. Areas of strength within state assessment data were proficiency and growth rates with 3FAY students. Also upward trends in math and AIMS Science. Gap area's identified in ELA and non 3FAY students.
