Needs Statement

Based on data analysis and AzMERIT results the Campus Improvement Team at Village Meadows Elementary School has identified a need to increase our overall Reading and Math proficiency for all students. Through differentiation and targeted instruction we will work collaboratively to increase student achievement and address all aspects of our students well being that impact their learning.

Goal Description

By the end of the 2017-18 school year 100% of Village Meadows students in grades K-3 will post the following results as measured by DIBELS Next:

Kindergarten will decrease Intensive from 79% to 39% or increase CORE from 12% to 44%.

1st Grade will decrease Intensive from 48% to 33% or increase CORE from 38% to 48%.

2nd Grade will decrease Intensive from 49% to 41% or increase CORE from 23% to 31%.

3rd Grade will decrease Intensive from 51% to 39% or increase CORE from 29% to 41%:

While 100% of 4-6 grade students will achieve a Lexile level at or above their grade level as measured by the Reading Inventory (RI) and/or demonstrate one years growth.

Additionally, Village Meadows will strive to increase AzMERIT ELA and Math scores by a minimum of 6% over the 2016-17 school year scores
