



# LAS BRISAS STUDENT/PARENT TECHNOLOGY AGREEMENT

Deer Valley School District offers 1:1 student technology. Students in kindergarten use preloaded iPads, while students in 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade use chromebooks. Grades 4 – 6 will have a device checked out to them. Other grade level devices will remain in the classroom.

Las Brisas takes students' safety very seriously, especially when it comes to using the Internet, iPads and chromebooks as learning tools. The Las Brisas Staff is committed to providing a safe and positive environment for all of our students when they use the technology available to them in the classroom. Teachers and staff will actively supervise and monitor student technology.

Using iPads and chromebooks as learning tools is a privilege. Students are expected to abide the rules of Network Etiquette as describe below. Please take a momet to go over the following bullet points with your student.

## Network Etiquette

- Only visit school approved websites.
- Keep your personal information safe. Never share username, passwords, home address or phone number with anyone or publish personal information online.
- Respect the privacy of peers and protect their personal information. Do not share others personal information online.
- Use technology as a positive learning tool.
- Keep all online communication with peers and teachers polite and respectful.
- Any online bullying or harassment is not tolerated.
- If you access anything inappropriate while on your device, promptly report it to a staff member.
- Only use your school issued e-mail account @learner.dvUSD.org while on a school issued device.
- All loaded music, images, data, files, videos or apps must be approved by your teacher or the school.

### **When using technology devices students agree to:**

- Handle their device with care
- Keep any protective covers that may come on the device in place. Do not remove.
- Keep device free from any and all stickers. Only painters tape is approved to go on technology devices. (Your student may write their name on painters tape then attach the painters tape to their chromebook.)
- Keep all food and drinks away from technology devices.
- Remember to bring chromebooks to school each day.
- Fully charge their chromebooks each night so they have a full battery each morning.
- Students 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade are financially responsible for all damage due to negligence or not utilizing reasonable care of device, loss and theft. (Purchasing the district protection plan is highly recommended.)
