PE Dress Code

1. Tennis Shoes that are required to be tied.
2. Athletic Shorts/Sweats are required. Color of bottoms may be student's choice.
3. Students will be issued a combination lock for the locker room locker. If lock is lost, student must replace the lock with a \$5.00 fee. No sharing lockers. Highland Lakes is not responsible for lost or stolen items left unlocked in the locker room.
4. Students will need to have a composition notebook and pen/pencil for health portions during the school year.

The Highland Lakes PE department will be selling uniform shirts for \$10.00 each. Uniforms will be available at our Middle School Back To School Night (To Be Announced) as well as the first week of school. All middle school PE students will be required to wear a uniform T-shirt to PE class every day.

MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE POLICY

Deer Valley Unified School District encourages students to take pride in their attire as it relates to the school setting. Students are to dress in a manner, which in addition to the following guidelines, takes into consideration the safety, health and welfare of self and others. Students, who volunteer for extracurricular activities such as athletics, band, chorus, etc., are subject to the standards of dress as defined by that activity sponsor. The final decision as to the appropriateness of dress shall be determined by the administration in accordance with District School Board Policy JICA-R.

1. Clothing must cover the entire buttocks. Shirts and tops may not expose bare midriffs, bare shoulders, nor be deeply or narrowly cut in the front, back, or under the arms. Halter tops, spaghetti straps, and strapless tops are not acceptable. Clothing that exposes undergarments will not be tolerated for males or females.
2. Bare feet are never acceptable. In the interest of safety, shoes must be worn at all times. Closed shoes are to be worn for any type of physical activity, such as physical education, cheer practice, weight lifting, etc.
3. Jewelry or ornamentation shall not be worn if it presents a safety hazard to self and/or others.
4. No hats may be worn (by staff members or by students) inside any campus buildings at anytime, except for properly approved occupational safety headgear required for special classes.
5. Defamatory writing, obscene language or symbols, or symbols of drugs, sex, or alcohol on clothing or jewelry are expressly prohibited.
6. Tattoos displaying defamatory writing, obscene language or symbols, or symbols of drugs, sex, or alcohol must be covered.

If the student does not follow dress code, he/she will be asked to call home for a change of clothing and will be assigned to the OCR Center until a change is made.
