Thematic Concepts:

- · Winter is one of the four seasons of the year.
- In places where it gets very cold in the winter, water freezes and becomes ice.
 In many places, it snows in the winter.

Language/Literacy:

- Become familiar with the name, shape and sound of the letter /Ww/.
 - Observe that words ending in /s/ often indicate more than one.
- Observe that a question mark tells us that a sentence asks something.

Math:

- Count by tens to 50.
- Review two-dimensional shapes.

Science:

- Begin to understand that winter brings changes in nature (temperature and/or types of precipitation).
 - Observe, predict, experiment and draw conclusions about states of water.
