



Preschool Newsletter for October 23rd-26th

This was the week of the pumpkin! We learned how pumpkins start as a seed and grow on vines, along with other foods such as tomatoes. We conducted an experiment to see if our pumpkin would sink or float. Ask your child how the pumpkin was able to float. The kids worked with their partners to guess how many cubes tall the pumpkin was before testing their theories. The best part was cutting into the pumpkin to discover pulp and lots of seeds! After some cleaning and cooking we were able to enjoy some tasty pumpkin seeds! Our next unit is called To Market, To Market. This unit will help expand the children's understanding of how foods get on the shelves and in the refrigerators at the grocery store.

Unit 6: To Market, To Market: week-1

Thematic Concepts:

- A market, or grocery store, is a place where we buy food.
 - There are different kinds of jobs in a market.
 - The grocery store sells different kinds of foods.

Language/Literacy:

- Become familiar with the name, shape and sound of the letter /Bb/
 - Speak in sentences.
- Explain that the title tells the name of a story.

Emotional Domain:

- Participate in activities to learn how to manage emotions in a positive way.
 - Recognize and acknowledge the positive behaviors of others.

Math:

- Count by rote to 17.
- Use nonstandard units of measure to measure familiar items.
