Dear Stetson Hills Families,

In order to promote social distancing, we have modified our arrival and dismissal procedures. Please adhere to the guidelines below to help us keep our campus safe and orderly. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

### Arrival Procedure

- Students may arrive between 8:30-8:45. Students will not be permitted on campus or in the office earlier than 8:30 unless you are part of Stallion Stables.
- We encourage all families to have a child(ren) walk or ride a bike whenever possible. This will help to alleviate congestion in the front parking lot.
- Front parking lot will be **DRIVE THROUGH DROP-OFF ONLY**, parents will remain in vehicles. Staff members will assist, as needed, with getting kids out of vehicles. Parents may not walk their children up to the building.
- Busses will maintain regular routing.
- Upon arrival to campus, students and adults are expected to wear their face-coverings.
- Students will report straight to their classroom. Those who need breakfast will stop by the cafeteria, pick up their food, and take their food to their classroom.

### Dismissal Procedure

- A staggered procedure will be used for dismissal. Dismissal will begin at 3:15.
- 3:15-Kindergarten students and/or siblings of kindergarten, and those who walk home or ride bikes
- 3:15 Kindergarten students being picked up by car will be taken to the blue line marked "Kindergarten Drop Off/Pick Up" (parents please remain in vehicle)
- 3:20 Students being picked up by car with last name A-L report to front parking lot (parents will have yellow placard, parents will remain in vehicle)
- 3:30 Students being picked up by car with last name M-Z report to front parking lot (parents will have red placard, parents will remain in vehicle) **\*M-Z Parents will not be permitted to wait at the blue line until 3:30. Please do not arrive before your scheduled time.**
- Bus riders will be dismissed as buses arrive; bus riders will report to normal bus quads as in prior years.
- Students are encouraged to walk or take the bus to limit parking lot traffic.

- Parents may not wait by bus gate or front parking lot (can meet students at off campus location) \*\*Note- parents of kindergarteners who walk and do NOT have a sibling may wait by the kindergarten gate.
- Students must wear masks during dismissal including while waiting for bus or parent pick up.
- As with morning drop-off, parents are to remain in cars at all times. The front parking lot is for **DRIVE THROUGH PICK-UP ONLY**.

**Kindergarten Students Day 1 (September 24 ONLY)**

One parent may drop off student directly to their classroom.

Last names beginning with A-L may arrive at 8:30

Last names beginning with M-Z may arrive at 8:45

In order to keep our campus safe and follow social distancing guidelines, parents are asked to quickly say goodbye and exit the campus. Please follow regular dismissal procedures.

**First Grade Students Day 1 (September 29 ONLY)**

Students may be dropped off at 8:20. Volunteers will be available to walk your first grader directly to their classroom. Parents must remain in the vehicle. Parents may still drop off first graders at the normal time (between 8:30-8:45) if you wish. Your child can find any adult in a green vest and we will help them to their classroom!

We ask drivers to refrain from blocking the bus bay, crosswalk, and parking lot entrance. Leave space when possible, and be patient with fellow drivers. We appreciate your cooperation in following all traffic and safety expectations to help assure a smooth and safe arrival and dismissal.
