



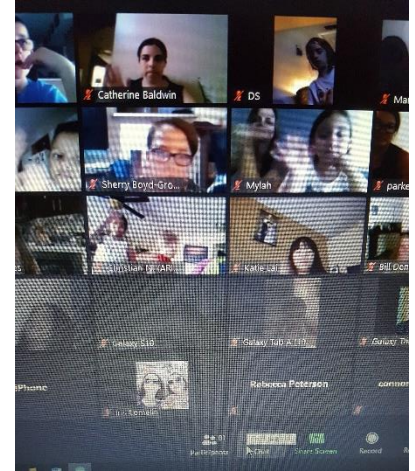
Title 1 Meeting Minutes

Reports

Mrs. Gilbert explained our school's participation in Title I stating that we receive funding based on at least 40% of our students qualifying for free or reduced lunch.

She explained how our funding is allocated providing us with teachers to work with kids that have some extra need for help including special teachers Mrs. Todd, Mrs. Teran and this year a math specialist, Mrs. Couture.

Part of our Title Plan is parent engagement and this includes our Leader In Me Parent academy which Title funds help to pay for.

Title 1 information was then sent out to parents that included:

Being a Title I school means receiving federal funding (Title 1 dollars) to supplement the school's existing programs. These dollars are used for...

- Identifying students experiencing academic difficulties and providing timely assistance to help these student's meet the State's challenging content standards.
- Purchasing supplemental staff/programs/materials/supplies
- Conducting parental Involvement meetings/trainings/activities
- Recruiting/Hiring/Retaining Highly Qualified Teachers

All Title I schools in Deer Valley are Schoolwide Programs. This means the Title programs serve all children in a school. All staff, resources, and classes are part of the overall Schoolwide program. The purpose is to generate high levels of academic achievement in core subject areas for all students, especially those students most in need.

Deer Valley schools set aside 1% of the Title I for parental involvement. All Title I schools emphasize bringing in parents as academic partners and each school receives funding to further this partnership.

New business

Principal Janet Gilbert and our Dean of Students Jessica Tucker shared information about Back to School, Meet the Teacher Night, following the district calendar during distance learning and food distribution.
