- If a student is more than 10 minutes late, it is recorded as an absence.

## Front Office Procedures

We encourage parents to assist students in arriving to classes on time.



- 🕒 If a student is late to class, after the final bell, the student is tardy.
- 🕒 If a student is late due to a medical, dental, or legal appointment or for any type of religious observance, a pass will be issued, if documentation is provided. These tardies do not count against a student's total.
- 📞 Phone calls will not be accepted to excuse a tardy.
- 📷 Parent/Guardian must report to the office and present a photo ID to request their student.

## Forgotten Items

In an effort to reduce interruptions to instructional time, as well as promote responsibility with our students, Barry Goldwater High School will only allow eye glasses or medically required items to be dropped off for students. Homework assignments, backpacks, projects, and musical instruments will be held for students but we will not interrupt classes.



You may drop off a forgotten lunch and your student can pick it up in the office. However, **NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS** such as Starbucks, McDonalds, Uber Eats, etc will be permitted.



Please don't call students or expect a text during class time. Students can use their phones during passing periods and at lunch. If you have an emergency, call the office and we will contact your student in the classroom.
