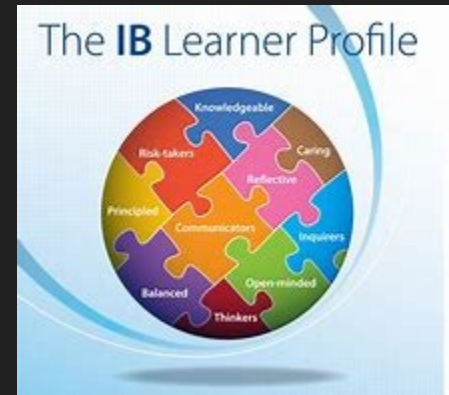
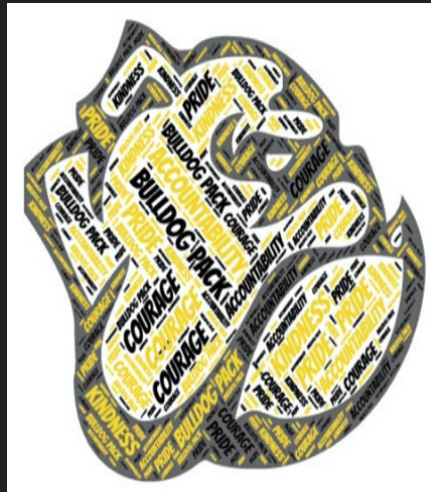

Every freshman has a G Crew leader who works with them throughout the year to offer support, guidance, and friendship.





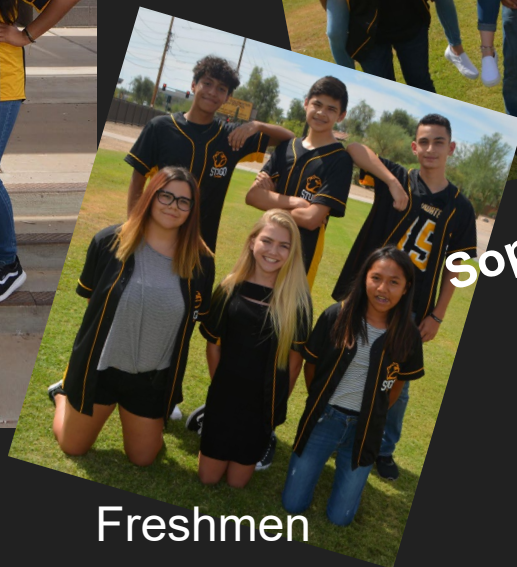
