

Graduation Song/National Anthem Audition Information Sheet

- **WHO:** Anyone interested in singing a Graduation Song and/or National Anthem at graduation.
- **WHEN:** MARCH 8, 2023 – 2:20 p.m. Wednesday
- **WHERE:** CHOIR ROOM
- **WHAT TO DO:** Sign up in the PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE for an audition time **YOU MUST SIGN UP TO AUDITION.**

Senior Song Information

- You may choose the song. It **MUST** have accompaniment (performance tape or instrumental accompaniment). For the song, judges will be looking for: Performance, Voice, Projection, and Appropriateness of Song.
 - The song must have something to do with major life milestones. Make sure the song is appropriate and relates to graduation.
 - You can modify the lyrics in a current song or write your own.
 - You **MUST bring 1 copy of the lyrics** to your song on audition day for the judges.
 - This can be a solo performance or a group. (*Remember all members of the group must be graduating.*) You must audition, as you would perform the piece with all members present at the audition.
 - ****If chosen, you MUST BE AVAILABLE to go to special rehearsals on May 17th – 8:00-9:00 a.m. at BC main auditorium and at the stadium on May 18th from 11:00 - 11:30 a.m. (Mrs. Sutton will bring you to the stadium for the sound check)**
- *If you have any questions, see Mrs. Sutton.**

National Anthem Information

- Graduating students also have the option of auditioning to perform the Star Spangled Banner. This can be sung or it can be instrumental. It may be performed acappella, with other accompaniment, or a performance tape.
 - This can be a solo performance or a group. (*Remember all members of the group must be graduating.*)
 - All members of the group must be present for the audition.
 - The same criteria for judging will be used as stated above.
 - ****If chosen, you MUST BE AVAILABLE to go to special rehearsals on May 17th – 8:00-9:00 a.m. at BC main auditorium and at the stadium on May 18th from 11:00 - 11:30 a.m. (Mrs. Sutton will bring you to the stadium for the sound check)**
