

DVHS Homecoming Dance Code of Conduct

The purpose of this code of conduct is to promote a healthy, safe, and enjoyable dance for all. The following behavior expectations, procedures, and consequences are designed to ensure a positive dance environment for all students, staff, and administrators.

The dance is over at 10:00 PM and students must be picked up within 30 minutes of the end time.

Code of Conduct

- Students will demonstrate good character, maintain a high standard of personal behavior, and adhere to all school and district rules and AIR expectations.
- Students will be required to show photo ID upon entrance into the dance.
- Students who bring a non-DVHS guest to the dance must enter and leave the dance with the DVHS student.
- Students are responsible for their personal items. The school is not liable for lost or stolen items.
- All school and district policies apply. This includes rules for search and seizure.
- Students in possession of any items related to vaping/tobacco will not be allowed to enter the dance and face possible disciplinary action.
- Students who dance inappropriately may be asked to leave the dance. This includes but is not limited to:
 - Inappropriate touching
 - Removal of clothing (including removal of shirts for boys)
 - Dresses/skirts lifted up
 - Grinding movements
 - Bending over in front of another student and/or placing hands on floor
- There is no re-entry. Once a student leaves the dance he/she must leave the premises.
- **Students who are not meeting the expectations included in this code of conduct will have to leave the dance early and will not receive a refund.**
