## Deer Valley High School Student Parking Rules and Regulations



Parking at Deer Valley High School is a privilege. Failure to comply with these rules may result in having your parking privilege revoked and your vehicle towed at your expense. Parking privileges may be revoked at any time.

- Students will be assigned a designated parking space and a corresponding hangtag. Students need to park in their designated space.
- Parking permits must be properly displayed. Display hangtag on the rearview mirror with the number facing toward the outside of the vehicle.
- Students are not permitted to loan, sell or trade hangtags.
- There is a \$5.00 fee for lost, stolen or mutilated parking hangtags. See security for replacement tag.
- The cost of a parking space is \$100 and <u>No Refunds</u> will be issued.
- Students are not permitted to park in the staff, admin or visitor lots unless it is after school hours.
- Speed limit in the parking lot is 5 mph.
- If a vehicle is parked in your assigned space, notify security in the parking lot to be assigned an alternate parking spot for the day.
- Park at your own risk. Deer Valley High School is not responsible for damage to vehicles or property.
- No loitering in the parking lot, in or out of the vehicle.
- Derogatory stickers, drawings, writing, banners or flags, are not allowed to be displayed on the vehicle. All must be school appropriate per the dress code/language in the student handbook.
- Students are not to leave campus or take other students off campus without following proper DVHS procedures, loss of parking privileges and/or disciplinary action will occur.
- Students may not go to their vehicle or be in the parking lot during school hours without prior approval or school designated escort.
- Unsafe driving: Joy riding, spinning tires, standing or sitting on the outside of vehicles while in motion is not permitted.
- If an accident occurs, report the accident to the parking security monitor immediately.
- Please see a campus monitor regarding parking (ticket) Written Warnings left on your vehicle. Ignoring these will result in an administration referral and possible loss of parking privileges.
- Search of a vehicle can and will take place whenever a school official has reasonable suspicion to believe that illegal drugs, alcohol, weapons or unauthorized person/persons are contained within the vehicle.
- If you need to drive a different vehicle than the one registered to be parked in your space, see the parking lot monitor.
- If you need to change your registered vehicle or add a second car to your space, bring your insurance and registration to security to add the vehicle.

Please remember to always wear your seat belt and do not text and drive!
