### Gifted Program Details -

**Cluster K-2:** Students who qualify as gifted are placed with the designated cluster teacher at that grade level. All cluster teachers are endorsed in gifted education and differentiate and extend lessons to meet the needs of the gifted learners.

**SAGE ELA:** 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> consists of Reading content replacement/pull-out program for students who score at or above 95 percentile on the Verbal Area of the CogAT assessment. This course is taught by the Gifted Specialist and utilizes the gifted curriculum from the College of William & Mary, informational and fiction resources and novel studies and supplemental sources involving grade level and accelerated state standards for ELA Reading and Writing. It incorporates assignments and projects based on topics studied with emphasis on state standards for Speaking, Listening and Presentation. Classes are combined, with 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> graders scheduled to meet daily for 60 minutes.

**SAGE ELA:** 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade consists of Reading and Writing content replacement/pull-out program for students who score at or above 95 percentile on the Verbal Area of the CogAT assessment. This course is taught by the Gifted Specialist and utilizes the gifted curriculum from the College of William & Mary, the Collections ELA text from Harcourt, informational and fiction resources and novel studies and supplemental sources involving grade level and accelerated state standards for ELA Reading and Writing. It incorporates assignments and projects based on topics studied with emphasis on state standards for Speaking, Listening, Writing and Presentation. Classes are combined, with 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders scheduled to meet daily for 60 minutes (6<sup>th</sup> grade an addition 30 minutes writing).

**SAGE Math:** 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade consists of Mathematics content replacement/pull-out program for students who score at or above 95 percentile on the Quantitative Area of the CogAT assessment. This course is taught by the Gifted Specialist and utilizes curriculum from Eureka math (3/4) and Illustrative Math (5/6) and supplemental programs that emphasis state standards from current grade level placement through at least one grade level above. Instruction is mostly acceleration based but also includes enrichment on Mathematics concepts. Classes are separated by grade levels and meet daily for 60 minutes.

### Gifted Testing -

**Gifted Testing and Scores:** Students are assessed in three areas (Verbal, Quantitative, & Nonverbal) using the CogAT assessment. Copper Creek offers gifted services for students who score at or above the 95 percentile in one or more areas. Placement testing is conducted three times a year based on teacher and parent recommendation. Students may also qualify based on other state approved gifted identification assessments. Students may only be tested once per calendar year.
