

STUGO MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT

It is a privilege to be a member in MRHS Student Government. I understand I must follow the rules stated below to remain a member in good standing in the program:

- I will show respect to the school and follow all rules set forth by The Students Rights and Responsibilities Handbook.
- I will show respect for others in the class, even though I will sometimes disagree with their thoughts.
- I understand that my grade is based on participating in activities during and after school and will be responsible for attending those activities. It is an expectation to be at all Stugo events, **failure to attend more than two events without proper permission could result in suspension and/or removal from Stugo.**
- While each member has a specific “title”, we will work as a team to make Mountain Ridge the best it can be. Each Class officer will be rotating titles each quarter in order to get an idea of all the leadership roles.
- I am expected to maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 (for Student Body Officers) and 2.8 (for Class Officers). **In addition, if any of my individual course grades drop to a D or F, I will be put on academic probation until the grade is up to a C.** This will be done with weekly grade checks.
- I will represent Stugo and MRHS in a respectful manner in-person and through social media.
- I understand that any actions unbecoming of a student government representative are grounds for dismissal for being a Student Government member and removal from the class, as stated in the student government by-laws.
- I understand that I am to be actively listening when class discussions are ongoing and my cell phone will be muted and not being used.
