LIBRARY COMPUTER KIOSK:

All library books are tracked in the computer using a program called “Destiny”. The computer kiosk, which is located near the Library Checkout counter is used by students to find books in the library.

What is the first thing you should do before beginning a basic search?

- Log In
- Click on the “Reset all” field next to the “Find” field
- Enter the title of the book

There are several ways to conduct a BASIC search for a book in the computer. Check all that apply:
