



PSAT Test

High school 11th grade students are highly encouraged to take the PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) in order to prepare for taking the SAT college entrance exam in their senior year. This test is also used as a qualifier for the National Merit Scholarship and the National Hispanic Recognition Program for students taking the test in their junior year.

The PSAT/NMSQT is a timed test that includes sections in math, critical reading, and writing skills (no essay is required). The test takes 2 hours and 45 minutes to complete. Students will receive score reports showing which answers they answered right and wrong, how they performed on specific academic skills, and how their scores compare to other students across the country.

Each high school in the district will offer the PSAT test. Students can register for the test at the links listed below
