DVUSD Facility Rental Contract 2020-2021
Additional Renter Requirements and Responsibilities

Disinfecting Requirements

Renter is responsible to disinfect rental space at **the end of each day** the facility is used in accordance with DVUSD cleaning and sanitation protocols.

1. Use an EPA Grade/Registered Disinfectant with a microfiber cleaning cloth
2. Disinfect all touch points:

Door handles	Toilet tissue dispensers
Light switches	Toilet flush valves
Desk/table (cafeteria tables/seats)	Stall doors, handles, latches, vertical surfaces, and railings
Paper towel dispensers	Faucets
Soap dispensers	Stair railings
3. Follow application guidelines as directed by product packaging.
Do not spray disinfectants directly on technology or products not recommended for direct contact with the disinfectant.
4. Please contact us if you need a list of approved EPA Grade/Registered Disinfectants.

Group Size

Renter is responsible to ensure group size does not exceed any current limitations for gatherings established by the State of Arizona, County of Maricopa, or local city ordinance.

Disease Prevention and Mitigation

In addition to the items listed above, renter is responsible to implement a program for disease prevention and mitigation while using District property that adheres to recommendations and requirements of the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Maricopa County Department of Public Health, and State and local guidelines such as required health screenings for individuals coming on District property, requiring attendees to social distance, wear a mask, wash hands, use hand sanitizer of 60% alcohol content or greater, and cleaning and disinfecting items and materials as well as touch points at the facility.

Disease and Illness Reporting

Renter shall report confirmed cases of Coronavirus/COVID-19 for individuals having been on District property. The report should not include the individual's name but must include all locations on the campus where the individual might have been within 48 hours of exhibiting symptoms, when the individual began to experience symptoms, and when the test was conducted and results received.

Contract Cancellation

DVUSD reserves the right to cancel the rental contract without notice if the renter is observed not following the requirements agreed to herein or operating outside of current health and safety requirements.
