### Donated Items Collected in 1<sup>st</sup> period

- Tissues

### Materials Kept in Backpacks for Personal Use

### Social Studies

- 1 spiral notebook
- 1 pocket folder

### \*\*Tips for keeping your 6<sup>th</sup> grade backpack light\*\*
