Categories and Weighting

ASSESSMENT **80%**

COURSEWORK **20%**

PRACTICE **0%**

Late & Missing Work:

- Late work submitted within 5 days from the end of the unit will reflect the student's actual score with no deductions or penalties.
- Work not submitted within 5 days from the end of the unit will be considered missing work and can no longer be submitted.
- Missing work (0%) will receive a 49%, by the end of the quarter.

My child is absent. What should they do?

- All work posted in **Canvas with due dates**; students are responsible for all work posted in Canvas
- Power Schools will list missing work. Power Schools offers parent accounts. See the front office for information.
- Homeroom, RTI, and lunch is set aside for any questions about missing work or re-doing work.
- *During class, make-up work will not be addressed.*
- Students may make an appointment to see me before or after school.
- Use INBOX in Canvas for any questions or concerns.
- Canvas Inbox/6th Grade Website/Email are all forms of communication to use when a student is missing work.



Reassessment:

Retakes are allowed for assessments in which scores are entered into the gradebook, for full credit.

In order to earn a retake opportunity, **a student must complete all of the following:**

- Complete all formative coursework related to the content/skill assessed
- Consult with the teacher
- Submit a reassessment plan or application, if required by the teacher

A reassessment plan must be scheduled within the following time frames:

- 6th Grade: Within 10 school days after receiving the assessment score

B = 80-89%

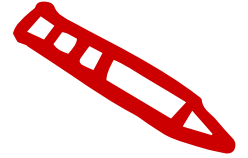
C = 70-79%

- SCALE in POWERSCHOOL

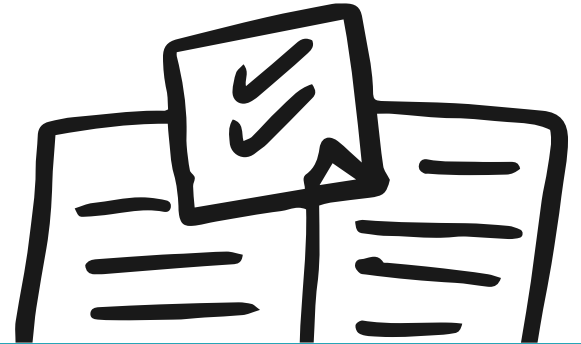
A = 90-100%
