## Front Office Procedures

We encourage parents to assist students in arriving to classes on time.



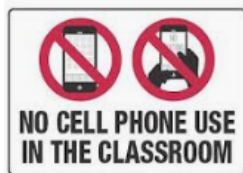
- ⌚ If a student is late to class, after the final bell, the student is tardy.
- ⌚ If the student is tardy multiple times, Administration may request a meeting with the parent and student.
- ⌚ If a student has an appointment slip, etc. from a doctor, dentist or other documented appointment to show in the office, a pass to class will be issued.
- ⌚ If a student needs to be picked up early for an appointment, please communicate this early so a pass can be sent to minimize classroom interruptions. Parent/Guardian must report to the office and present a photo ID to request their student.

## Forgotten Items

In an effort to reduce interruptions to instructional time, as well as promote responsibility with our students, Barry Goldwater High School will only allow eye glasses or medically required items to be dropped off for students. Homework assignments, backpacks, projects, and musical instruments will be held for students but we will not interrupt classes.



NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS such as Starbucks, McDonalds, Uber Eats, etc will be permitted. You may drop off a forgotten lunch and your student can pick it up in the office.



Please don't call students or expect a text during class time. Students can use their phones during passing periods and at lunch. If you have an emergency, call the office and we will contact your student in the classroom.
