Reading: For this week's reading selection, students will learn to visualize characters and events, analyze plot and historical setting, and interpret the author's use of figurative language and imagery, using a historical fiction text.

Writing: Students will begin drafting their informative/expository essay.

Social Studies: This week we are wrapping up our unit on Mesoamerican civilizations. We are also celebrating Sandra Day O'Connor Civics Day by looking at how we use the democratic process for decision making.

Science: This week students will develop and/or revise a model using various rock types, fossil locations, and landforms to show evidence that Earth's surface has changed over time.

Math: We will be finishing topic B which students examine multiplication patterns when multiplying by 10, 100, and 1,000 and start topic C.

Mandarin: We will continue to learn Intermediate 1 unit 1 characters and learn story 'Clothes-Shopping For Little Fish'.
