

Student Council Elections

Academic Expectations:

Students must be in good academic standing in order to run for and hold a position of representative or officer. No 0's or 1's. No missing work.

Behavior Expectations:

If a Student Council member gets a referral, the team teachers and the student council advisor will review the offense to decide whether or not the member should be released from their position on the council. If a Student Council member gets a suspension, for any reason, the representative will be removed from position on the council.

Executive Officer Duties:

The executive officers of this organization shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Historian. Officers will be at every student council event and meeting.

- A. **Duties of the President-** The president shall preside at all Student Council meetings, call special meetings when necessary, appoint all standing and special committees, represent the Council on all occasions, and assume all other duties generally associated with this office.
- B. **Duties of the Vice-President-** The Vice-President shall assume the duties of the president in case of his/her absence or disability.
- C. **Secretary-** The secretary shall keep a record of all meetings of the Council and provide a bulletin, published when necessary, to be posted on the Student Council Website. At the close of the school year, the minute book shall be filed by the secretary in the Student Council files. In addition, the secretary shall carry on correspondence of the Student Council and shall keep a record of attendance.
- D. **Treasurer-** Keep track of all ingoing and outgoing money. Plan & propose budget for events.
- E. **Historian-** The Historian records the activities of the Student Council through use of video, photo, written reports, and the Student Council webpage. Duties include uploading the meeting minutes onto the webpage.

Campaigning-

Students campaigning will need to write a speech (1-2 minutes) and record it to be played for all students. Videos may be submitted through email to Ms. Whittingham (Room 228) or turned in on a flash drive by September 10th. Students campaigning may not hand out any candy, food, toys, prizes, or monetary bribes.
