## Kindergarten

Individual Student Supplies - LABEL EACH ITEM WITH YOUR CHILD'S FIRST AND LAST NAME:

- 70-page spiral-bound notebook
- 2 plastic two-pocket folders (1 purple, 1 green)
- 2 one-inch clear-view binders (NAME ON INSIDE COVER)
- 1 pair of headphones for iPads – please place in a GALLON sized Ziploc bag with child's name-no earbuds please

Inside a pencil BOX: (please label the box with child's name-NO ZIPPER pouches please)

- 2 dry erase markers - no red please
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 pair of Fiskar scissors
- 4 pencils (Ticonderoga brand lasts the longest)
- 1 pink pearl eraser

## **4th Grade**

### **Individual Student Supplies:**

- Zippered pouch or small school supply box for pencils/supplies (must fit in backpack)
- Headphones/earbuds (in Ziploc bag with name)
- 2 heavy-duty two-pocket folders (with prongs; can be “fun” or plain; just not green, red, or purple)
- Pencils (Ticonderoga brand lasts the longest) or package of mechanical pencils (enough to last the whole year)
- 1 pencil sharpener with cover (NO electric or battery please)
- Colored pencils (12 pack) - suggested: 2 packs (1 per semester)
- Colored markers (optional - 10 pack)
- Highlighters (minimum 2 different colors)
- Scissors
- Glue sticks: 10-12 -- (used frequently in class - students need throughout the year)
- Dry-erase markers (6-8 BLACK EXPO) -- used daily in class
- Dry-erase eraser (optional)
- 2-3 red ink pens (keep extras at home)

### **Supplies needed by Subject Area:**

**ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS** (SAGE reading students DO need these materials; they attend ELA with Mrs. Sumner)

- 1 GREEN heavy-duty plastic folder
- 20 sheet protectors - insert these into green folder with prongs
- 1 subject Spiral Notebook WIDE RULED - green preferred but black is okay if green is unavailable)
- Composition notebook - green preferred (but black is okay)

**MATH** (SAGE math students DO NOT need these materials, as they attend SAGE in place of 5th grade math)

- 1” ONLY 3-ring binder - any color binder with folder pockets on inside - will be kept in Mrs. Thomas’ classroom
- Composition Notebook
- Dry erase markers (black)
- Ruler (inches & centimeters)

### **SCIENCE**

- 1 PURPLE heavy-duty plastic folders without prongs
- 2 PURPLE spiral notebooks (single subject; one per semester)
- \* Colored pencils (see above)

- 1 RED heavy-duty plastic folder with prongs
- 2 composition books (any color is fine)

- 1 heavy-duty two-pocket folder (label the inside pockets "take home" and "bring back"; with or without prongs is fine; can be "fun" or plain, just not green, red, or purple)
- Pencils (sharpened or mechanical)
- Hand-held sharpener if using regular pencils (must collect the sharpenings) OR lead replacements if using mechanical
- 2 or more red ink pens
- Scissors
- 2 different colored highlighters (yellow, pink, or orange preferred - avoid dark colors)
- Art materials - one or more of the following: colored pencils, crayons, and/or thin markers/flair pens
- Glue sticks (used regularly in all classes - students will need multiple throughout the year)
- Dry-erase markers (used daily in math - students will need multiple throughout the year)
- Personal earbuds or headphones (these can be found at dollar stores) - Bluetooth earbuds are NOT compatible with our Chromebooks
- Stylus for touch-screen Chromebook (optional; these can be found at dollar stores)

  - 1 GREEN heavy-duty plastic folder labeled "ELA" (no prongs)
