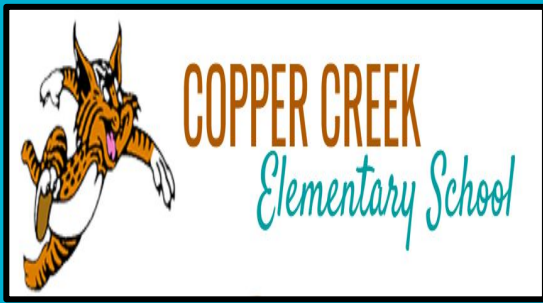

Meet the Teacher Open House

- This night is intended to be a meet and greet with the teacher and to familiarize your child with their new classroom
 - Grade Level welcome videos will be sent to families by Tuesday, Aug. 2nd – these videos will include curriculum information, daily schedules, and other timely information for each grade level
 - Enter our Meet the Teacher Open House through the MPR (Multi-Purpose Room/Cafeteria) – there will be staff available to help guide you to classrooms
 - Stop by the stations set up in the MPR and then proceed to your child's classroom
 - Please bring any CLASSROOM supplies/donations with you to drop off in your child's classroom
 - The administration team will be present all night and we look forward to seeing you
 - The front office will be open to answer any questions you may have

First Day of School

- Parents may walk their children to their classroom at 8:15 for the first day of school only and there is not a need to sign in at the office on this day
- Please be patient with the parking lot especially on the first day of school, we are all so excited to be at school and there will be lots of traffic

School Procedures

Kinder – Arrival



- Kinder gate opens at 8:15
- Curbside drop off
- Stop at "Kinder Drop Off" sign
- You will stay in your car and have your child's name plate displayed on the passenger side of your windshield (signs will given to you at Meet the Teacher Night (8/1/22))
- Your child's car seat should be unbuckled prior to the teacher letting them out of the car
- **Older siblings are dropped off with the youngest

Kinder - Dismissal



- Curbside Pick - up
 - 3:10 gates open
 - Pull up to “Kinder Pick-up” sign
 - Be sure your child's name plate is displayed on the passenger side of your windshield. Parents remain in your car.
 - During pick up your child will need to be able to buckle themselves in as we cannot do that for you. If your child cannot buckle themselves into their car seats you will need to pull over in the parking lot to buckle your child in. Please do not hold up the line to do that.

1st Grade – Arrival



- Drop off begins at 8:15
- Curbside drop off
- Drive up to the "1st Grade Drop Off/Pick Up" sign (PAST the first crosswalk in front of the school)
- Be sure your child's name plate is displayed on the passenger side of your windshield (signs will given to you at Meet the Teacher Night ..8/1/22)
- Your child will be directed by a duty teacher to enter the courtyard through the gate, there will be another duty teacher in the courtyard to ensure they make it into the building through the front door.
- **Older siblings are dropped off with the youngest

1st grade - Dismissal



Please do not forget to put your sign in your windshield after the 1st day!



Students will be waiting here with their teacher for pick up.

- Curbside Pick - up
 - 3:13 gates open
 - Pull up to "Drop off/ Pick-up" sign area
 - Be sure your your child's name plate displayed on the passenger side of your windshield (this will be given to your child at Meet the Teacher Night on 8/1/22)
 - First grade teachers will be there on duty
 - They will look at the sign in the windshield and call for your student
 - All first grade students will be in the front with a teacher ready to be picked up
 - Your child will not be left unsupervised

2nd Grade Arrivals



- Drop off begins at 8:15
- Curbside drop off
- Drive up to "Drop Off/Pick Up" sign (PAST the first crosswalk AND the "hump" crosswalk)
- **Walkers/Drop off** will enter the school through the **courtyard** Your child will be directed by a duty teacher to the courtyard.
- **Older siblings are dropped off with the youngest

School Safety

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- All gates will be locked during the school day
 - Visitors must sign in at the front office and wear a visitor's sticker
 - Fire drills are practiced monthly
 - Lockdowns are practiced quarterly
 - Students may not be signed out during a lockdown or fire drill
 - All volunteers must attend training before going into classrooms or attending field trips. (Dates for trainings coming soon!)
 - Evacuation Location: Deer Valley High School

Front Office Procedures/Volunteers

To assist the office staff with safety, please....

- Have I.D. ready when you come in the office to sign out your child
- Office staff will check ID and buzz visitors through the doors to access nurse, media center, cafeteria, and classrooms
- Parents are permitted to walk to their child to the classroom only on the first day of school
- Prior to 3:00 we are happy to relay messages and sign your child out
- Volunteers are welcome on campus this year, please contact your child's teacher to discuss volunteering in the classroom (you will need to be volunteer trained)
- Visitors are welcome this year during any school wide assemblies or programs
