

How to Erase All Data from Your iPad and Reset

*** Remember you MUST have your iPad charged to AT LEAST 75% to turn it in AND reset it using the directions below.

Clear all debt in the bookstore, including any damage to your iPad, missing brick, or missing cord, BEFORE you start senior checkout

- 1) Launch the Settings app from the Home screen on your iPad
- 2) Under the general tab, scroll to the bottom and select Transfer or Reset iPad
- 3) Select Erase All Content and Settings
- 4) Select Continue
- 5) Enter your passcode for the iPad that you use to unlock it
- 6) Enter your Apple ID Password
 - a. If you can't figure out your Apple ID Password please email the media center specialist: sue.barsky@dvusd.org and let her know you need your Apple ID reset.
- 7) After you enter your Apple ID, select Erase iPad
- 8) The iPad will reset!! Make sure it charged to at least 75% and turn it off to save the battery. You will be required to turn it back on at checkout so we can verify it's charged.
