DURING TALON TIME ON 3/23/23 *

· **Any student that is a repeat offender of either the use or possession of Vape Devices, THC Wax Pens, Alcohol, and other illegal items will be subject to the appropriate school discipline as well as a referral to our School Safety Officer for a citation.**

· Violations as noted above can impact the following:

- **Open Enrollment Status**
- **Current Parking Privileges on Campus**
- **Future Parking Privileges on Campus**
- **Future Status at SDOHS (i.e. Long Term Suspension / Expulsion)**

- **Graduation Privileges (Walking at Graduation)**

· SDOHS would also like to inform parents and students that there should never be more than one student in a bathroom stall. **If multiple students are found together in a bathroom stall, all students will be subject to search based on reasonable suspicion of vaping and subject to disciplinary action, to include suspension.**
