To determine if your program/project meets the qualifications for consideration, take the [Eligibility Quiz](#) and begin the online application process
NEW GRANT MAKING SCHEDULE:
Deadlines for Submission: February 1st and August 1st (new organizations/1st time submitting)
May 1st (returning organizations – funded at least once in last 10 years)
Grants Awarded: May 1st & November 1st (new) and August 1st (returning)

Winning Schools’ funds administered/delivered by: end of February, 2019
- **Bonnie Plants 3rd Grade Cabbage Program**

Delivery of free cabbage plants to students in 3rd grade throughout the country
Teacher registers class online and is contacted by Bonnie Plants salesperson who delivers plants to school in time for growing season; each student receives a unique, hands-on gardening experience through growing colossal cabbages for 8-10 weeks; students then submit a digital image of themselves with their cabbage and one student is selected as “best in state” and is awarded a \$1,000 scholarship towards education by Bonnie Plants

Note: ARIZONA is NOT a prioritized geographic region for Project Learning Garden Program

Teachers in K-12 who have an agriculture-related project they would like to conduct during the 2018-2019 school year are eligible to apply for a \$500 CHS Classroom Grant. Projects funded in the past include school gardens, embryology projects and other agriculture-related initiatives that help educators teach reading, writing, math, science, social studies and more. Fifteen (15) grants of \$500 each will be awarded.
